Every dot on this board has a name. For example; The first dot on the top left corner is called "A1", because it's in the column of "A" and in row "1".

Here you have ➡ a list of dots with it's name. Draw a line between the dots according to the order they are listed here.

- C6 B7 D7 C6 C5 B4 B2 D2 D4 C5
- L6 K7 M7 L6 L5 K4 K2 M2 M4 L5
- C14 B15 D15 C14 C13 B12 B10 D10 D12 C13
- L14 K15 M15 L14 L13 K12 K10 M10 M12 L13
- F4 I4 I7 H8 H10 I11 F11 G10 G8 F7 F4

Rolling!


Follow the path of the chips : For some of them the path to the bottom is blocked!

Sudoku Seder




This Sudoku is for younger children.

Place the pictures in each column and each row; every row, (horizontal or vertical) should now contain all 4 pictures.


Use the pictures provided next to each Sudoku puzzle. Enjoy!

Let's make an Afikomen Bag!



