When you bake a big batch of challah you are given the opportunity to do the mitzvah of Hafrashat Challah, Separating the Challah.

The moment of separating challah is an especially auspicious moment for praying and turns the simple act of baking into a spiritual experience.

Here is our step by step guide on how to do Hafrashat Challah.

STEP 1

Make a double or triple batch of your favorite challah using at least 5 pounds of flour. For a challah recipe, visit www.jewlish.com or <u>click here</u>.

STEP 2

After you have mixed up the ingredients and formed a dough, recite the following blessing.

בְּרוּך אַתָּה יהוה אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֱלֶּךְ הָעוֹלָם אֲשֶׁר קִדְּשְׁנוּ בְּמִצְוֹתִיו וְצִוְנוּ לִהַפִּרִישׁ חַלָּה מִן הָעִּסָּה. Blessed are You, Hashem, our God, King of the universe, Who has sanctified us with His commandments, and has commanded us to separate challah (from the dough)

Baruch Atah Adonai Elohainu Melech Haolam Asher Kiddishanu B'mitzvotav Vitzivanu L'hafrish Challah (min ha'isa)

STEP 3

Say your prayers, for yourself, for your family, for Israel, for peace and for our soldiers. You can use the following prayer for our soldiers.

STEP 4

Discard the separated challah either by wrapping it in plastic so that it doesn't come in direct contact with the rest of the trash or wrapping it in aluminum foil and burning it while nothing else is in the oven.

STEP 5

Once your challah is baked and ready make sure to share some with your friends and community with a note asking for prayers for Israel and peace.
